

Honorable Thomas W. Clark graduated from Pocatello High School, Brigham Young University (BS Business Finance, Minor in Accounting and English), and University of Idaho College of Law (Juris Doctorate Degree). Prior to his appointment to the bench, he enjoyed private practice for 26 years in Pocatello with Clark & Clark (6 years); Whittier, Souza & Clark (6 years); and Merrill & Merrill (14 years).

Judge Clark was sworn in as a Magistrate Judge in Bannock County on December 30, 2009. Since his appointment, he has presided over the Domestic Violence Court in Bannock County. He has responsibility for all misdemeanor charges for domestic battery, domestic assault, stalking, violations of No Contact Orders and Civil Protection Orders. He has been a member of the Statewide Domestic Violence Advisory Team for the past 11 years and co-chairperson for the past 2 years. He is currently serving as the Sixth Judicial District Executive Board member of the Idaho Magistrate Judges Association.

Judge Clark served as President of the Sixth District Bar Association (1996-97), President of the Portneuf Inn of Court (2000-01), and was the recipient of the 2010 Idaho State Bar Professionalism Award for the Sixth Judicial District. His volunteer efforts include Past President of the Rotary Club of Pocatello (2009-10) and numerous positions serving young mem and serving in his Church. He has been married to his wife, Camille, for 41 years and they have 5 children and 17 grandchildren. Judge Clark was appointed to serve as a member of the Idaho Judicial Council on January 27, 2021.
