**TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR THE POSITION OF
DISTRICT JUDGE OF THE FIFTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT**

The Idaho Judicial Council is in the process of selecting nominees to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of the Honorable Robert J. Elgee, effective May 31, 2017. Notice is hereby given that the Judicial Council is extending the deadline for accepting applications for the position of District Judge of the Fifth Judicial District with chambers in **Blaine County**. In accordance with Idaho Code § 1-2102(3), it is the policy of the Idaho Judicial Council to extend the application deadline whenever there are fewer than four (4) applicants. The judge shall hear cases in Blaine County as well as when necessary in other counties within the Fifth Judicial District to which he or she may be assigned.
