

NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF DEADLINE TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR THE
POSITION OF DISTRICT JUDGE OF THE FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT
ELMORE COUNTY

Notice is hereby given that the Judicial Council is extending the deadline to submit applications for the position of District Judge of the Fourth Judicial District with chambers in Elmore County. The extension is made in order to comply with *Idaho Code* 1-2102(3) which directs the Council to submit three or four names to the Governor for each vacancy.

Under Idaho Code § 34-616 (5), to be appointed to the office of district judge, a person must, at the time of appointment meet all the following qualifications:

- (a) Be at least thirty (30) years of age;
- (b) Be a citizen of the United States and an elector in the state of Idaho;
- (c) Have been a legal resident of the state of Idaho for at least two (2) continuous years immediately preceding such appointment;
- (d) Have been in good standing as an active or judicial member of the Idaho state bar for at least two (2) continuous years immediately preceding such appointment; and
- (e) Have held a license to practice law or held a judicial office in one (1) or more jurisdictions for at least ten (10) continuous years immediately preceding such appointment.

In addition, as described in Idaho Code 1-809, district judges shall actually reside at the place designated as resident chambers.

You **must** use the revised **1/15/2024** application form. **COMPLETED APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED IN THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL OFFICE NO LATER THAN 3:00 P.M., AUGUST 24, 2026.** Applications should be submitted to:
