

**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR TWO (2)
POSITIONS OF DISTRICT JUDGE OF THE FOURTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT**

Notice is hereby given that the Judicial Council is now accepting applications for **two (2)** positions of District Judge of the Fourth Judicial District with chambers in Elmore and Ada Counties. The Idaho Judicial Council is starting the process of selecting nominees to fill:

- 1) the vacancy created by the appointment of the Honorable Theodore J. Fleming appointed to the Court of Appeals, effective immediately and,
- 2) the vacancy created by the retirement of the Honorable Patrick J. Miller, effective January 19, 2027.

The salary of a district judge as of July 1, 2026 is \$172,508. (Comprehensive information about the benefits afforded district judges is available by clicking [here](#).) The judge shall hear cases in Elmore and in Ada Counties as well as when necessary in other counties within the Fourth Judicial District to which he or she may be assigned. **Please designate by cover letter whether you are applying for one or both positions.**

Under Idaho Code § 34-616 (5), to be appointed to the office of district judge, a person must, at the time of appointment meet all the following qualifications:

- (a) Be at least thirty (30) years of age;
- (b) Be a citizen of the United States and an elector in the state of Idaho;
- (c) Have been a legal resident of the state of Idaho for at least two (2) continuous years immediately preceding such appointment;
- (d) Have been in good standing as an active or judicial member of the Idaho state bar for at least two (2) continuous years immediately preceding such appointment; and
- (e) Have held a license to practice law or held a judicial office in one (1) or more jurisdictions for at least ten (10) continuous years immediately preceding such appointment.

In addition, as described in Idaho Code 1-809, district judges shall actually reside at the place designated as resident chambers.
