The Idaho Judicial Council is starting the process of selecting nominees to fill the vacancy created by the retirement of the Honorable Alan C. Stephens, effective February 22, 2018. The judge shall hear cases in Jefferson County as well as when necessary in other counties within the Seventh Judicial District to which he or she may be assigned.

Under Idaho Code § 34-616 (5), to be appointed to the office of district judge, a person must, at the time of appointment meet all the following qualifications:

- (a) Be at least thirty (30) years of age;
- (b) Be a citizen of the United States and an elector in the state of Idaho;
- (c) Have been a legal resident of the state of Idaho for at least two (2) continuous years immediately preceding such appointment;
- (d) Have been in good standing as an active or judicial member of the Idaho state bar for at least two (2) continuous years immediately preceding such appointment; and
- (e) Have held a license to practice law or held a judicial office in one (1) or more jurisdictions for at least ten (10) continuous years immediately preceding such appointment.

In addition, as described in Idaho Code 1-809, district judges shall actually reside at the place designated as resident chambers.
